On behalf of the committee here are the following updates for the Jazz Brunch:

Venue:

Smyrna Event Center

- ♦ Venue has in-house catering,
- Liquor is allowed to be brought in and served by a licensed bartender for a fee (fee is listed in itemized costs below)
 - Newest development- The sale of alcohol is prohibited at this venue; drink tickets can be sold prior to the event, but not at the event center
- The itemized costs go as follows:

Stage Fee for the band: \$375

- Room Rental: \$1150

- 18% Production Charge: \$1088.82

- Sales Tax: \$695.94

- Food and Beverage (\$32.95 per person for 120 guests): \$3954
- Bartender portable bar fee \$570
 - Approximate total costs \$7833.76
- Contract has been signed, but to reserve this date officially with the venue, a deposit of \$1150 will need to be made no later than 2/17
- As of 2/13, the venue deposit of \$1150 has been made, securing the venue for the date of 8/2/25.

- Prices per plate are \$32.95
- A Contract and Banquet Event Order (BEO) will be issued to all parties after menu selections and details
 are made. These forms need to be completed not less than 30 days before your event.
- Head counts and estimates are due to the catering office 7 days prior to the vent.
- Serving will be buffet style that will remain open for 1.5 hours once the dining begins; 40 people minimum required

- To meet a break-even margin(with the libations being donated) we could sell tickets at \$75 per person, \$600 for a table, which seats 8 ppl; 136 tickets, would need to be sold to break even
