Below is a preliminary cost estimate for preparing and distributing 104 complete meal boxes.

- 104 Gravy Packets
- 104 Cranberry Sauce
- 208 Macaroni Boxes
- 104 Brown and Serve Rolls
- 208 Green Bean Cans
- 208 Corn Cans
- 104 Sweet Potato Cans (40 oz each)

Estimated Food Cost: \$3,142.84

Packaging Supplies:

• 104 Standard Duty Office Boxes (approx. \$2.50 each)

Estimated Box Cost: \$260.00

Total Projected Cost: \$3,402.84

Per-Meal Box Cost: \$32.70 per box (including packaging) very rough estimate it will be solidified next meeting

The final cost: Using the Krogers app with two items on sale final cost was under \$23 for items wanted excluding 104 turkeys

Next Steps

1. Fundraising Push:

 Engage last year's partners Corinthian No. 8 and Mt. Nebo No. 67.

- Present sponsorship opportunities to other district bodies and supporters by setting a clear ask of \$33 per box or whatever we land on as actual cost next report.
- Encourage individuals or groups to sponsor one or more boxes.
- 2. **Logistics Planning:** Assign responsibilities for procurement, storage, transportation, and on-site distribution.
- 3. **Packaging:** Secure and prepare office boxes, and confirm transportation support to the McFerrin Center.
