The Charity & Community Engagement Committee submits this report on the launch and early progress of our 2nd Annual Sock Drive for the Unhoused, supporting the ongoing work of St. Vincent Catholic Outreach in Nashville.

Progress to Date

- The official flyer has been distributed, and the drive has been formally launched across lodge communication channels.
- A QR code has been implemented to streamline giving. When scanned, it directs donors to a curated online registry of sock options.
- The delivery address is automatically added at checkout, ensuring all purchased items are shipped directly to Kirjathjearim Lodge No.104 for collection.
- Lodge #104 will deliver all donated socks to St. Vincent Catholic Outreach at the conclusion of the drive on April 30.
- Early participation has been strong. As of the latest registry update, the following items have been purchased:
